## **Internship**

## Residency

A 5 years integrated academic program with surgical training at King Abdullah University hospital (KAUH) which is a tertiary hospital covering the whole north of Jordan with a population of around 2 million. Also, the program is supervised by Jordan University of Science and Technology (JUST) granting the graduate with a Higher Degree in Medicine. During the program I was exposed to a wide range of specialties gaining surgical knowledge and skills. As I became a last year resident I was able to perform most of the common general surgical procedures (Laparoscopic and open) independently with minimal or no direct supervision. also, I was involved in teaching and supervising my junior colleagues. Moreover, as KAUH is the primary teaching hospital for JUST medical students I was involved in the teaching process of medical students including teaching rounds and morning reports.

I worked for around six months in the hospital having my own practice and clinic as a General surgery specialist.

I was involved in teaching both 4<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> year medical students during their surgical rotations this includes teaching rounds, morning reports, seminars and lectures. Also, I was involved in teaching residents and interns.

## Plastic Surgery Fellow/ KAUH

I was a full time fellow at the plastic surgery service at KAUH. This includes covering clinics and emergency plastic cases under supervision. Also, in theatre, I performed minor plastic procedures under supervision and assisted in major plastic and reconstructive procedures.

I was a full-time clinical fellow at STH NHS trust in the Plastic surgery department for almost 3 years, I had been on the Registrar Rota shortly after my start.
