I also attended seminars, grand rounds on regular basis as well as medical conferences. I also participated in some research projects.

3. Medical Officer (August 2008- November 2008)

This is a temporary work, during which I worked as a Medical officer (Paediatrics) in the United Relieves and Works Agency (UNRWA), Irbid, Jordan. This post involved treating a range of Pediatric patients presenting with wide range of medical conditions.

4. Pediatric Residency Programme (July 2004- June 2008)

Four years as a resident Doctor in Paediatric Medicine at King Abdullah University Hospital, Irbid, Jordan. This is a structured training program which leads to the award of the" High Specialty in Paediatrics" certificate after completing the clinical training and passing the relevant written, Oral and Clinical examinations. It includes treating a wide range of Paediatric patients under consultants' supervision.

This training programme involved rotation in different Paediatric subspecialties including Paediatric Gastroenterology, Respiratory Medicine, Neurology, Nephrology, Infectious diseases, Neonatology, Intensive care Unit, Haemoncology and Emergency Paediatric Medicine. In addition, daily morning reports, weekly Grand rounds, journal clubs and group discussions as well as seminar presentations formed an integral part of this residency program. I was trained to do a range of Paediatric Procedures including: Lumber Puncture, urine catheterisation, intubation, insertion of chest tubes, Liver biopsies, bone marrow aspiration and umbilical catheterization. It also included regular on-call duties.
